Strasbourg airport: 1 300 000 passengers/year

Connected to the biggest European hubs:

- Amsterdam : kim base to 150 destinations
- Madrid: IBERIA / base to 70 destinations worldwide
- Istanbul: Description of the standard street of the sta
- Lyon: AIRFRANCE / base to 43 destinations

Other direct connections from Strasbourg:

<u>Domestic Flights</u>: Ajaccio, Bastia, Biarritz, Bordeaux, Figari, Marseille, Montpellier, Nantes, Nice and Toulouse.

International: Agadir, Algiers, Athens, Barcelona, Berlin, Casablanca, Constantine, Corfu, Djerba, Faro, Fez, Gran Canaria, Lanzarote, London, Majorca, Nador, Olbia, Oran, Oujda, Palermo, Palma, Porto, Rome, Split and Tunis.

The airport is served up to 5 times an hour by a shuttle train, which Strasbourg station in 8 minutes! (\leq 3.00 one way).



STRASBOURG. AN ARCHITECTURE BETWEEN TRADITION...

The historic city centre, the "Strasbourg Grande Ile", was classified as a World Heritage site by UNESCO in 1988: the first time such an honour was granted to an entire city quarter in France

Strasbourg, Grande-Île and *Neustadt* inscribed on the World

Heritage List in 1988, extended in 2017



... AND AN URBAN PROWESS: THE IMPERIAL DISTRICT

The former imperial quarter, built between 1880 and 1918, is a legacy of the German period and forms the Neustadt.

 The monumental urban planning and wide avenues embody an exemplary vision of the German city of that time.

 July 2017: The German Neustadt is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site






It owes its third place to a policy of bold greening implemented through its Canopée 2020-2026 plan, which aims to increase the tree cover in the city, more actively renew the tree population dying trees and to further develop the way in which trees are planted.


Adapting tree care to the new climatic conditions in order to adapt to climate change.

The goal: to plant 10,000 additional trees by 2030! The city is also focusing on The city's 1,050,000 m² of green spaces, cultivated with zero pesticides and differentiated management, provide the equivalent of 259 soccer pitches of plants!




